1 Peter 3:15

discover

The gospel is good news! As Christians, we should make it our mission to share that news with as many people as possible! The good news of Jesus brings us hope, which is something that a lot of people in our world are missing. As Christians, we find hope in the sacrifice that Jesus made for us when He died on the cross and gave us the gift of eternal life. First Peter 3:15 tells us to always be prepared to give a reason for the hope that we have.

develop

Sharing your faith might not always be easy, especially if you're afraid of being judged or looked at differently because of what you believe. It can seem intimidating, but sharing what God has done in your life can help others recognize their need for the hope that we have in Jesus Christ. Be bold in telling others about how Jesus has personally impacted you or why you are a Christian. Many times, people are way more receptive to hear about Jesus when I'm able to share a testimony of a time in my life that God brought me through. Through my testimony, they recognize the power of Jesus at work within me and they want that same power inside of their own heart!

Sharing faith can look different for each of us. Some may feel called to give their testimony in front of a large audience. Others may use their social media to spread the gospel. Some people may lead a Bible study to share God's Word. No matter how you share the gospel, know that you are helping plant seeds of hope.

Take a look at the people around you. Have you ever told your family or friends about what God has done or is doing in your life? If not, this can be the perfect opportunity to share your faith. We are living example of God's faithfulness; all we have to do is share it with others! You never know the difference you may make—not only in someone's life, but in their eternity.
